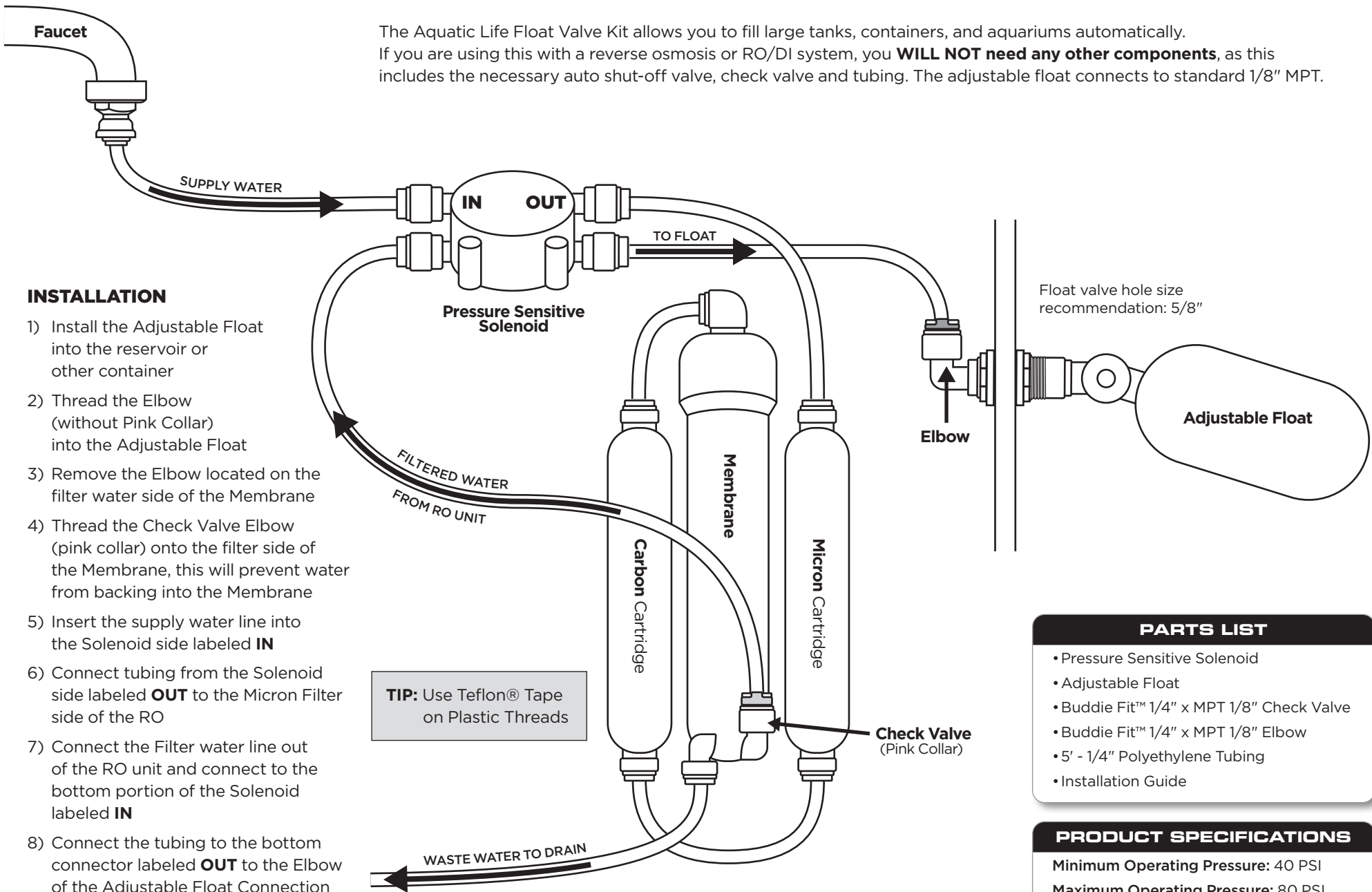


The Aquatic Life Float Valve Kit allows you to fill large tanks, containers, and aquariums automatically. If you are using this with a reverse osmosis or RO/DI system, you **WILL NOT need any other components**, as this includes the necessary auto shut-off valve, check valve and tubing. The adjustable float connects to standard 1/8" MPT.



INSTALLATION

- 1) Install the Adjustable Float into the reservoir or other container
- 2) Thread the Elbow (without Pink Collar) into the Adjustable Float
- 3) Remove the Elbow located on the filter water side of the Membrane
- 4) Thread the Check Valve Elbow (pink collar) onto the filter side of the Membrane, this will prevent water from backing into the Membrane
- 5) Insert the supply water line into the Solenoid side labeled **IN**
- 6) Connect tubing from the Solenoid side labeled **OUT** to the Micron Filter side of the RO
- 7) Connect the Filter water line out of the RO unit and connect to the bottom portion of the Solenoid labeled **IN**
- 8) Connect the tubing to the bottom connector labeled **OUT** to the Elbow of the Adjustable Float Connection

TIP: Use Teflon® Tape on Plastic Threads

Float valve hole size recommendation: 5/8"

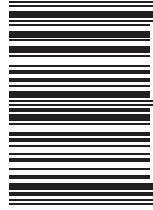
